Telephone Relay Services

Telephone Relay Service Text to Voice TTY

Phone: 800-735-2900 or 711 in state

Services: Provides people with a speech or hearing disability to communicate on the telephone. The caller uses a device called a TTY to type their conversations. The communication assistant then relays this info to the person being called and types back their response to the disabled person.

Telephone Relay Service Voice Carryover (VCO)

Services: Provides people with a speech or hearing disability to communicate on the telephone. This service uses a TTY. The caller uses their own voice to talk, but receives the replies via text on their TTY.

Telephone Relay Service Hearing Carry Over (HCO)

Services: Provides people with a speech disability to communicate on the telephone. The service uses a TTY. The caller types his/her part of the conversation and listens to the response.

Telephone Relay Service Spanish Language

Services: This allows Spanish speaking people with a speech or hearing disability to communicate on the telephone in their own language. This is traditional TTY service in Spanish. See above description of TTY service for more info.

Telephone Relay Service Speech to Speech

Services: Provides communication assistance to people with speech disabilities that are difficult to understand on the telephone. The communication specialist helps by translating the callers conversation.

Telephone Relay Service: Other Services

Services: Other services that are offered by telephone relay service or TSR include caption telephone service, video relay service, and IP relay. Caption telephone service allows someone hard of hearing to read the other parties response via captions that appear on their phone using voice recognition software. Video Relay service is for people who's primary language is American Sign Language or ASL. This service uses video conferencing equipment to relay the messages from the caller and the responder in ASL. IP relay is similar to TTY except the person with the disability uses the internet instead of a TTY machine to communicate. IP relay is convenient for people with internet access because it allows them to do more things like conference calls.
