COMMITTEES

Committees of The Arc typically meet monthly on a regular schedule that works for the members involved. Committee minutes provide the regular reports of committee activity required by the Board of Directors.

□ **DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE**

The Development Committee monitors existing fund sources of The Arc of Benton County and researches and develops potential new sources of revenue, both short and long term.

□ **FINANCE COMMITTEE**

The Finance Committee is responsible for review and oversight of the fiscal management of The Arc of Benton County and assists staff in implementing sound fiscal policy and practice.

□ **MEMBERSHIP COMMITTEE**

The Membership Committee recommends and carries out membership development and retention activities for The Arc of Benton County.

□ **PROPERTY MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE**

The Property Management Committee develops and recommends to the Board appropriate policies and procedures for residential options that exist under the auspices of The Arc of Benton County. The Committee considers the health, safety and general good will of the individuals, their staff and their families who are supported by these options as it develops the policies. Further, the Committee monitors the implementation of the policies and procedures. It also advises on issues of acquisition, maintenance and repair of properties and related contracts.

□ **PUBLIC POLICY COMMITTEE**

The Public Policy Committee monitors all public policy that may impact citizens with cognitive and related disabilities and their families and, with The Arc of Oregon and The Arc of the United States, assists in the provision of systems advocacy and legislative/congressional advocacy.

□ **RESALE COMMITTEE**

The Resale Committee develops and makes recommendations to the Board on policy/procedures and the general operation of The Arc Resale Corner and The Arc Resale Center and related activities.
